Signing In Procedure

All Volunteers need to sign-in at one of the kiosks for each service they are working. We are using this system to help with the attendance count done each Sunday.



Parents MUST show their parent tag when picking up children. This is part of our Plan to Protect procedures and is vital for the safety of all children in our care.

First Aid

The First Aid Kit is in the kitchen in the drawer under the phone.

Epi-pens: There are four children who have epi-pens with them. Pictures of the children are posted by the sound system. Procedure of use:

1. Stab into the thigh
2. Have the number "99" put up along with the child's number. Medical professionals in the congregation have been asked to go to the Welcome Desk when 99 flashes. Please meet them at the Welcome Desk to explain the need.
3. Call 911.

- All other classes exit out the east doors.
